- 1. Do you believe that Jesus Christ is God, always has been God and always will be God?
- 2. Does your teaching teach that Jesus Christ's blood was the atonement for my sins?
- 3. Do you believe that His death is in my place and that He, the Son of God, is worthy of my faith?
