Important principles to know:

• For sound <u>interpretation</u> of the books, chapters, and verses of the Bible.

The Bible teaches us by:

- Inference...What is <u>implied</u> in the scripture passage.
- Precept...<u>Commands</u>, imperatives.
- Example...
 - o Good...follow
 - o Bad...don't follow

We must use scripture to <u>interpret</u> Scripture.

- Get a good reference Bible.
- Seek out all the scriptures on a subject.
- Get the whole story, i.e. harmony of the gospels.
- Law of first mention.

You must know the difference between:

- Parable A parable may have many principles but only ONE main point.
- Precept This is a <u>command</u>.
- Proverb General statements with a general <u>result</u>.
- Promise A promise is a <u>promise</u>.
- Principle A fundamental <u>truth</u> or proposition that serves as the <u>foundation</u> for a <u>system</u> of belief or <u>behavior</u> or for a chain of <u>reasoning</u>.
