- B. Last week
 - 1. “full of goodness” – inwardly good
 - 2. “filled with knowledge” – they were learning and applying what they had learned
 - 3. “able to admonish one another” – they cared deeply

- D. They had a missionary heart – verses 15-16a
 - Word “Gentiles” means nations

Part 1

Introduction

- A. It's the winter of 56 or 57 in the city of Corinth
 - B. Verses 17-29 are not words concerning the Roman Christians – but of words concerning Paul

- I. His Philosophy: As it relates to his accomplishments – verse 17
 - Word “glory” or “boasting”
 - A. Accomplishments give us a reason for inner encouragement – verse 17
II Samuel 6
 - B. Whatever is accomplished is done through us – not by us
 - C. All accomplishments are actual – they are not imaginary – verses 18b-19a
