Introduction

- A. The book of Romans is a letter on the righteousness of God.
 - 1. A letter that talks about God imparting His righteousness to the believing sinner.
 - 2. It is also a book on the plan of salvation.
- B. The issue of the Jews is what is at the hand in Paul's mind.
- C. Paul begins to express great feelings of emotion – verses 1-3
- D. Another reason his feelings are so intense is that they (Jews) were the recipients of marvelous blessings of God – verses 4 – 5 List 8 of them
